Falmouth Foreside enhanced by new Mussel Cove home

This elegant new cottage-style contemporary features Arts and Crafts detailing, a marvelous gourmet kitchen, a first-floor owner's suite tucked behind a pocket door, and a dramatic great room with lofty vaulted ceiling, all in a fabulous Falmouth Foreside setting.

The home is as comfortable as it is spacious. The great room is warmed by a corner gas fireplace, and brightened by huge windows that "bring the outside in." In the kitchen and the dining space, cranberry brown granite counters blend beautifully with the wet bar's cherry cabinetry and the gleaming oak floors. On the end wall, white subway tile beneath a range hood flanked by transom windows is another adroit touch. Appliances are sleek, stainless Jenn-Air.

The owner's suite, with huge walk-in closet and gorgeous bath; an airy formal dining room; laundry, just off the mudroom; and a soundproofed powder room complete the first floor.

The second story's generous balcony space provides both an open office and a sitting area. A large, finished bonus room is at one end of the hall; at the other are two big, carpeted bedrooms, each with double closet, and each served by a full bath.

The high-ceilinged basement offers a 1,000-square-foot expanse, separate from the utility area, that would make a great media room or exercise space, to mention just two possibilities.
